Ponies:

Our Miniature Shetland ponies "Bella, Pippa, Missy, Spirit" are calm, gentle, and love spending time with you. They're perfect for brushing, petting, and offering that special pony cuddle. They happily navigate around your home, don't worry if you are unable to sit out of bed. Our ponies will join your bedside for special cuddles and rest there heads and even have a little nap themselves.

Small Animals:

 Our Rabbits and Guinea Pigs are calm, soft and cuddly. They are ideal for offering comfort and companionship. Their soft fur and gentle nature provide the most amazing comforting sensory experience

Farm Animals:

- Our Goats and Sheep are always friendly and curious, they bring an element of fun and excitement as you get to observe them up close.
- Our Chickens and Ducks are a fun way to observe and interact, learning about their natural behaviour in a safe, controlled environment. Our Chickens especially will happily sit on your arm for a stoke, or even perch on your head. Our Cockerel is always the star of the show with his cock-a-doddle-do.

- Goat & Sheep Diapers: During indoor visits our goats and sheep wear special diapers, to ensure cleanliness and prevent any mess, allowing you to relax and enjoy the time with our animals
- **Protective Shoes:** To safeguard your floors and prevent slipping, our ponies wear specially designed protective shoes. These shoes are non-slip and floor-friendly, ensuring both the ponies' safety and the protection of your home.
- Animal Welfare First: Each animal is transported with their welfare in mind, with regular breaks, comfortable transport conditions, and plenty of care to ensure they are calm, happy, and stress-free on arrival.
- Small Animal Baskets: Our Rabbits and Guinea Pigs happily sit all day long in there special baskets being stroked and loved. This is for your safety preventing scratches from little claws and for the comfort of the animals, as they are not being picked up or handled in correctly.

How are Pricing Works

Pricing

We offer a range of visit options to cater to different needs:

•One Hour Visit with One Pony or Small Animals or Farm Animals: £150

•One Hour Visit with One Pony & Small Animals or One pony & Farm Animals or Two Ponies: £225

•One & Half Hour Visit with One Pony or Small Animals or Farm Animals: £200

•One & Half Hour Visit with One Pony & Small Animals or One Pony & Farm Animals or Two Ponies: £275

•Two Hour Visit with One Pony or Small Animals or Farm Animals: £250

•Two Hour Visit with One Pony & Small Animals or One Pony & Farm Animals or Two Ponies: £325

Fuel Charges

We apply a **fuel charge** to cover travel costs and ensure our animals are transported safely and comfortably.

We offer free travel for the first 10 miles (5 miles each way), and after that, we charge £1.50 per mile for any additional distance.

Example Fuel Charge Calculation:

If you are located 30 miles away from EverDale Stables:

- Total Distance (Round Trip): 60 miles
- First 10 Miles Free: Subtract 10 miles, leaving 50 chargeable miles.
- Fuel Charge: 50 miles \times £1.50 = £75

Additional Charges:

Ultra-low emission or congestion zone fees (if applicable) will also apply.

As we travel across the country we recognise that travel costs can add up over long distances. To help minimise expenses, we aim to coordinate visits with nearby facilities whenever possible, sharing travel costs to provide a more cost-effective solution for everyone involved.

Benefits of Multi-Home Visit

- Fuel charges are divided among all participating homes, reducing costs for each.
- Residents in all homes benefit from enriching animal therapy sessions at a significantly reduced cost.
- Coordinating visits promotes community collaboration and sustainability.
